YOUR DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1: PRAGUE – Upon arrival in Prague, we are met and greeted by our assistant, and next board our deluxe coach to transfer to the river cruise port where we embark on the ship. After a welcome cocktail we enjoy our dinner on the ship. Overnight on the ship. (D) Passengers are welcome to board the ship at 6:00 p.m.

DAY 2: PRAGUE – Today we explore Prague's rich history and charm, starting at the lively Old Town Square. Marvel at the Jan Hus Memorial and the Old Town Hall with its famous Astronomical Clock. We visit the stunning Church of Our Lady before Týn, and stroll through the historic Ungilt courtyard. Continue to the Powder Tower before crossing the iconic Charles Bridge with views of the Vltava River and Prague Castle. Our tour ends at Wenceslas Square, where history meets modern life in a vibrant cultural setting. In the afternoon we explore Prague's captivating Castle District, starting at the vast Prague Castle, the largest ancient castle in the world. Admire the stunning St. Vitus Cathedral, stroll along the charming Golden Lane, once home to alchemists and craftsmen, then visit the Old Royal Palace, where Bohemian kings ruled. Continue to St. George's Basilica, one of Prague's oldest churches. We end our journey through the picturesque streets of Lesser Town, where Baroque architecture and cozy cafés await. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 3: PRAGUE / LITOMERICE – We continue our sailing towards Melnik where we board our coach and travel to Litomerice. We explore that charming royal city nestled where the Elbe and Ohře rivers meet. Our guided tour takes us past the Saxon Renaissance town hall, the "Kalich" House with its rooftop terrace, and the "Černý orel" House, known for its beautiful sgraffito artwork. We visit the Gothic Church of All Saints, the Church of the Annunciation of the Lady Mary, and the Baroque Cathedral of St. Stephen. To cap off the experience, we enjoy a glass of wine at the nearby Velké Žernoseky winery, followed by a refreshing beer tasting before returning to your ship at the pier in Roudnice. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 4: LITOMERICE / BAD SCHANDAU / DRESDEN

This morning we continue our sailing through the magical landscape of Saxon Switzerland. We arrive in Bad Schandau where we embark on a captivating journey through the Elbe Sandstone Mountains. Our adventure leads to the imposing Königstein Fortress, a 13th-century stronghold perched high above the river. As we explore this historic site, enjoy panoramic views of the Elbe River and the surrounding mountain ranges, immersing yourself in both the region's natural beauty and its rich, layered history. After this unforgettable excursion, return to your ship with memories of a journey through time and nature. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 5: DRESDEN / MEISSEN – This morning we embark on a three-hour walking tour through the historic city of Dresden, a blend of culture and stunning architecture. We begin at Zwinger Palace, a Baroque gem housing the renowned Old Masters Picture Gallery and porcelain collection. Next, stroll along Brühl's Terrace, known as the "Balcony of Europe," with scenic views of the Elbe River and the city skyline. Continue to the Dresden Cathedral (Hofkirche). As we wander through the Old Town, pass by the iconic Semper Opera House and Theater Square, home to architectural masterpieces. Our tour concludes with the reconstructed Frauenkirche, a magnificent Baroque church restored after WWII. After the tour we return to our boat and sail towards Meissen, a picturesque town near Dresden renowned for its rich history and porcelain craftsmanship. We begin at Albrechtsburg Castle, a Gothic masterpiece offering stunning views of the town and Elbe River. Next, we visit the Meissen Cathedral, a blend of Romanesque and Gothic architecture, with a beautiful interior that reflects its historical importance. The highlight of the tour is the Meissen Porcelain Manufactory, founded in 1710. Before returning to Dresden, we enjoy free time exploring Meissen's quaint town center, filled with charming shops and cafés. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 6: MEISSEN / WITTENBERG – We leave Meissen in the morning and continue sailing towards Lutherstadt Wittenberg, a city that played a pivotal role in the life of Martin Luther and the Reformation. Known as the "Cradle of the Reformation," this UNESCO World Heritage city is a testament to the events that shaped Christian history. Our tour begins in the heart of Wittenberg, where you'll wander through streets lined with Renaissance-style houses. Visit Markt Square, where a statue of Luther and Philip Melancthon stands proudly. Our next stop is the famous All Saints Church (the Castle Church) where Luther nailed his 95 Theses to the door and stop by the graves of Luther and Melancthon inside the church. Next, we visit the Church of Saint Mary (the Town Church) where Luther preached most of his sermons. Our last stop is the Augusteum where we explore the special exhibition "Literally Luther: Facets of a Reformer". This thoughtfully curated exhibition offers a multifaceted look at Martin Luther's life, legacy, and influence, highlighting rare manuscripts, personal items, and insights into the man behind the Reformation. ****Please note: The Lutherhaus is currently closed for renovation and is expected to reopen in spring 2027****. We return to our ship in the late afternoon. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 7: BURG / GENTHIN / BERLIN – Today we arrive in the city of Magdeburg, once the cradle of the German nation. We start with the Magdeburg Cathedral, home to the tomb of Emperor Otto I. We continue our tour by visiting key sacred monuments like the Magdalenenkapelle, St. Petrikirche, Wallonerkirche, and the Monastery of Our Lady. We see the replica of the Magdeburger Reiter statue and the impressive bronze door of the town hall. After the guided tour, we enjoy some free time to explore on our own. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 8: BERLIN – This morning, we embark on a guided tour of Berlin's historic landmarks. Starting on the 17th of June Street, we see the Victory Column, Bismarck Memorial, Brandenburg Gate, and the Reichstag building with its glass dome. We continue to the renowned Unter den Linden and Museum Island, home to significant museums like the Pergamon Museum and Alte Nationalgalerie. We also visit Alexanderplatz, where the Martin Luther statue stands near St. Mary's Church and the Fernsehturm. We explore Checkpoint Charlie, the symbol of the Cold War, and visit the Berlin Cathedral, featuring statues of the four Reformers. In the afternoon we travel to Potsdam where we visit the gardens of Sanssoussi Palace and tour around Sanssoussi park, admiring its many remarkable buildings. The day ends with some free time in Potsdam's charming Dutch district. (Note: There will be no interior visit to the Sanssoussi Palace.) Tonight, we enjoy our farewell gala dinner. Overnight on the ship. (B/L/D)

DAY 9: BERLIN – After breakfast we transfer to the airport for our flight back home. (B)

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Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 75 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 75 days, a late fee will be accessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Journeys Unlimited requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Journeys Unlimited.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Journeys Unlimited assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Journeys Unlimited will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

Air from Home City: All brochure departures are based on a New York area airport. Journeys Unlimited can help arrange air transportation from your home city airport. Journeys Unlimited is not responsible for any penalties incurred on domestic tickets not purchased from us, in case of changes in the schedule of the tour. If you are making your own domestic airline tickets, please make sure that your domestic flight time arrives at least 4 hours prior to your international departure time.

Air Changes, Cancellations & Refunds: Airline tickets issued by Journeys Unlimited are highly restrictive and in most instances cannot be reissued, revalidated or exchanged. If a change is possible, a \$75 per person administrative fee, plus any applicable airline change fees, will be assessed once air tickets have been issued. Airline penalties vary depending on carrier.
